Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and Explorers collected enough food to supply almost one-third of the meals served to the needy in Monroe County and surrounding areas! Our partnership with the Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired (ABVI/Goodwill Industries) brings much needed promotion, publicity and plastic bags for the collection of food and clothing. Last year we collected over 60 tons of food and close to 40 tons of clothing. We hope to do even more in 2012.

The 2012 drive begins with bag distribution on Saturday, March 17th and bag pick-up on Saturday, March 24th. There will be three bags distributed to each household – one for food, one for clothing and one for electronics – all bags will be picked up and taken to a designated collection site.
