Relay Race – Six stops from Swifts Landing to Norsen Bridge Park in Newark

Rules:

1. Life jackets on and fastened at ALL times when on the water.
 2. MANDATORY use of aluminum canoes.
 3. Swim certification mandatory for all participating in this event!
 4. Minimum of four (4) preferable six (6) per canoe.
 5. EVERYONE in the crew must race once before a crew member can race again.
 6. RESPECT property of those living along the creek. DO NOT step on crops if you can possibly help it.
 7. STOP to help each other in distress if you are the nearest canoe and the Safety Canoe is not close enough to reach them quickly.
 8. Show GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP and the principles of Boy Scouting.
- NO HORSEPLAY!**

Bring:

1. Sneakers or water shoes to wear in the water and canoe.
 2. A change of clothes.
 3. Sunscreen/Raingear (weather appropriate).
 4. Something to drink.
 5. Snacks
 6. A dish to pass and your table service for a picnic at the end (hot dogs and hamburgers will be provided!).
- Baseball/bat/glove, Frisbee, volleyball and net for games following the race.
