BE SURE TO READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CAMP LEADERSHIP - All leaders who are responsible for the group must be registered members of the BSA. A minimum of two qualified adults will be in charge of the unit during the entire period of the unit's stay in camp. At least one of these leaders must be over 21; the other may be a responsible leader 18 or older. All leaders must file a Massawepie Scout Camps Adult Leader Form, approved by the troop's Committee Chair or Chartered Organization.

BILLING INFORMATION - The Seneca Waterways Council Operations Committee has revised the fee payment schedule for our Boy Scout Camps for 2012. This revision consolidates the policies of our two former councils and responds to many suggestions from units.

Please read the following instructions carefully.

By December 1, 2011 – NO PER PERSON FEES ARE DUE! A total of \$100 per Unit is due, which will hold your Troop reservation until March 12, 2012. Please also let us know an updated estimate of the numbers of youth and adults that will be attending camp.

By March 12, 2012 - \$100 per Scout and \$50 per leader is due. The initial \$100 unit fee paid by December can now be credited toward Scout fees. **Be sure to indicate the number of Scouts and the number of leaders that you are paying for. Only those spaces will be reserved for your troop.**

By May 21, 2012 – The balance of all payments is due.

ADDITIONAL PAYMENT INFORMATION

IF MAKING RESERVATION PRIOR TO DECEMBER 1, 2011

Enclose with your application a payment of \$100 to hold a 2012 Babcock Hovey Camp reservation. ***This fee is non-refundable but will be applied to your total fees.*** and a second payment of \$100 per Scout and \$50 per leader is due on March 12, 2012. ***Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.***

IF MAKING RESERVATION AFTER MARCH 12, 2012

Enclose with your application a payment of \$100 per Scout and \$50 per leader reservation deposit. ***Payments are non-refundable (except as noted below) but can be transferred to new campers.***

THE BALANCES OF ALL CAMPING FEES ARE DUE BY MAY 21, 2012.

CAMPERSHIPS are available for Seneca Waterways Council members participating at Summer Scout Camp. Campership forms are due to the Council Servicerter by **April 16, 2012.**

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: All payments are due at the Council Servicerter payable to Seneca Waterways Council

December 1st Initial **non-refundable** \$100 deposit per unit fee is due.

March 12th Second **non-refundable** payment of \$100 per Scout and \$50 per leader fee is due. **Be sure to indicate the number of Scouts and the number of leaders that you are paying for. Only those spaces will be reserved for your troop.**

May 21st Final payment is due in full for all campers (youth & leaders).

REFUND POLICY - **ALL fees paid are non-refundable** but may be transferred to a new camper. **PARTIAL REFUNDS** will only be considered for cancellations due to medical reasons or summer school. Medical cancellations will require a doctor's note; summer school cancellations will require a note from a guidance counselor or other school official. The \$25 non-refundable registration fee will not be returned. After June 30, contract commitments increase the non-refundable amount to \$50 regardless of the reason for the cancellation. Requests for partial refunds must be made no later than August 31. Requests made after that date will not be considered.

MEDICAL FORMS - Medical forms are required for every person in camp. The council must keep these medical forms. Be sure to make copies of the form before you come to camp. Be prepared to leave a copy of the medical form at camp. Keep the original in a safe place. **COPIES CANNOT BE MADE AT CAMP, AND THEY CANNOT BE PROVIDED AT A LATER TIME.**
