**Cub Scouts:** Imagine yourself as a pirate, a knight in shining armor, a buckskin clad frontiersman, a Native American or a mountain man. Come to Cub Scout Adventure Camp at the J. Warren Cutler Scout Reservation, near Naples, and live your fantasy. For 3 days and 2 nights, you'll find fun and adventure in one of five villages – sailing ships, a castle, a fort, an Iroquois longhouse and a mountain man tent camp.

With your parent (or adult partner) you can swim; boat; shoot archery, BB guns or slingshots; and enjoy great campfires and themed village programs. Camp Cutler is one of only 20 Cub Worlds in the nation!

**Webelos:** Choose from 2 different weeks (July 12 - 17 or August 2-7). You will be able to use all the Cub Scout Adventure Camp program facilities, and you can earn all required activity badges for your Webelos and Arrow of Light awards. Plus, you will sleep in tents on platforms, just like Boy Scouts do, and have your own Webelos program.

With 6 days and 5 nights of Boy Scout style camping, this exciting program helps second year Webelos transition into full Boy Scout camping.
