COPIES CANNOT BE MADE AT CAMP, AND THEY CANNOT BE PROVIDED AT A LATER TIME.

- Traditional Camp Payment Schedule -

2. In February you will receive your 1st invoice with an additional payment of \$50 per person due prior to March 22. Be sure to specify on your check (or a separate sheet of paper) the Scout(s) and/or adult(s) you are paying for.
3. A 2nd invoice will be sent in April with final payment due prior to May 3. Be sure to specify on your check (or a separate sheet of paper) the Scout(s) and/or adult(s) you are paying for.
4. Take a copy of your medical form to camp with you.

REFUND POLICY - ALL fees paid are non-refundable but may be transferred to a new camper. PARTIAL REFUNDS will only be considered for cancellations due to medical reasons or summer school. Medical cancellations will require a doctor's note; summer school cancellations will require a note from a guidance counselor or other school official.
