Eagle Scout Board of Review Schedule and Information

Bay Waters, Black Creek, Genesee Crossroads,
Lighthouse, & Towpath Districts*

On each Board of Review date (listed to the left), we will see a maximum of 9 (occasionally 12) Eagle Scout Candidates. Once the Board of Review is full, Scouts will be scheduled for the next board. Paperwork needs to be submitted two weeks prior to the Board of Review. Last minute submissions (after the two week deadline) will be considered at the discretion of the council and only if all paperwork is in order.

When submitting paperwork and preparing for your Board of Review, please note these important items:

- ✓ Original Copies of the Eagle Scout Rank Application and Eagle Scout Project Workbook must be submitted. Please make sure that all proper names, addresses (including city and zip code), and signatures are on the application and workbook.
- ✓ Please submit a photo copy of the Eagle Project Workbook. The original will be returned to the Eagle Scout Candidate after his Board of Review. The copy will be retained by the Council.
- ✓ Make sure that all dates for advancement awards, merit badges, and tenure requirements are listed and accurate.
- ✓ A statement of Eagle Scout Candidate's ambitions and life purpose as well as a listing of positions, honors, and awards are enclosed. See Requirement #6 on the Eagle Scout Rank Application.
- ✓ A religious reference is listed. A statement of belief in a higher power may be submitted if the Eagle Scout Candidate does not have a religious reference.
- ✓ At least three reference forms or letters must be submitted by the candidate's troop on or before the Board of Review. These can be submitted with the application and workbook. They should not be sent directly to the council by the references.
- ✓ Each Eagle Scout Candidate should be accompanied to his Board of Review by an adult representative from his troop. The representative will sit on his board as well as one to three other Scouts' boards. Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, and relatives cannot serve as representatives.
- ✓ Applications need to be submitted on or before the Eagle Scout Candidate's 18th birthday.
