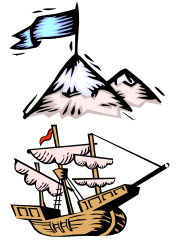

New For 2012 – Pack Deposit: To reserve space in a 2012 Cub Adventure Camp session and village(s), submit this form by December 31, 2011 with a deposit of \$100 (per Pack). This deposit is non-refundable, but will be applied to the total fees of your group. No roster is needed at this time. Complete this form, indicating the number of the session chosen. Make a realistic estimate of the number of youth and adults that will be registering for each village and mail the form with your Pack check to the address on the back. These slots will be held through March 1, 2012. Note: reservations are made on a first-come, first-served basis.

EARLY RESERVATION BONUS

Any Pack that makes its initial reservation with the \$100 deposit by September 30, 2011 will receive an additional 1% discount off its total Pack Camp Registration Fees.

*** In these Sessions, Family Camping will be available in all Villages except Mountain Man and Native American for Youth ages 4-11. Parents MUST attend with any non-Cub Scout Campers(s).**

+ In Sessions 3, 4, 9, and 10 Mountain Man will not be available. Instead the Webelos Week Program will be held during those dates.

Notes:

- To reserve spaces after Dec. 31, 2011, submit this form with a Camp Pack roster. Instead of the \$100 Pack deposit, include a deposit of \$50 per person.
- Registration for 2012 is by Pack, not by individual family as in previous years. However, if a family wants to go to camp and the Pack is not sending a group, or the group is going at a time the family cannot go, the family can register by sending in this form with an initial \$50 per person deposit. This deposit is non-refundable, but will be applied to the total fees. The parent lists their name as the leader on this form, and attaches a roster of youth and adults attending.

CAMP PAYMENT SCHEDULE

By December 31, 2011: A **non-refundable** deposit of \$100 per Pack is due with this reservation form to reserve a Session(s) and Village(s) for the Pack.

Any Time: Update your reserved totals, or add new campers (on space-available basis), by contacting the Camping Department at (585) 241-8545 or camping@senecawaterways.org. After March 1, new campers can be added only with a \$50 deposit; after May 1 new campers will require payment in full.

By March 1, 2012: Submit a roster of the youth and adults who will attend camp, with a deposit of \$50 (or the full Camp Fee to take advantage of the early payment discount) per person. Your \$100 Pack deposit can be credited to this payment. **Note: If all campers pay in full by March 1, the next step does not apply.**

By May 1, 2012: Unless all campers in your Pack paid in full by March 1, you will receive an invoice in March showing the remaining fees due. Pay this by the May 1 regular fee deadline.

All Payments: Make a single Pack check payable to Seneca Waterways Council, BSA and mail to 474 East Avenue, Rochester, NY 14607.

REFUND POLICY – ALL fees paid are non-refundable but may be transferred to a new camper. PARTIAL REFUNDS will only be considered for cancellations due to medical reasons or summer school. Medical cancellations will require a doctor's note; summer school cancellations will require a note from a Guidance Counselor or other school official. There is a \$30 non-refundable fee per person that will not be returned regardless of the reason given for cancellation. After June 30, contract commitments increase the non-refundable amount to \$50 per person for the three day session and \$75 for Webelos Week, regardless of the reason for the cancellation. Requests for partial refunds must be made no later than August 31, 2012. Request made after that date will not be considered.

MEDICAL FORMS – The **Annual Health and Medical Record** forms are required for every person in Camp. The Council must keep these medical forms. Be sure to make copies of the form before you come to Camp and bring it to Camp. Be prepared to leave a copy of the Medical Form at Camp. Keep the original in a safe place.

NOTE: COPIES OF MEDICAL FORMS CANNOT BE MADE AT CAMP AND THEY CANNOT BE PROVIDED AT A LATER TIME
