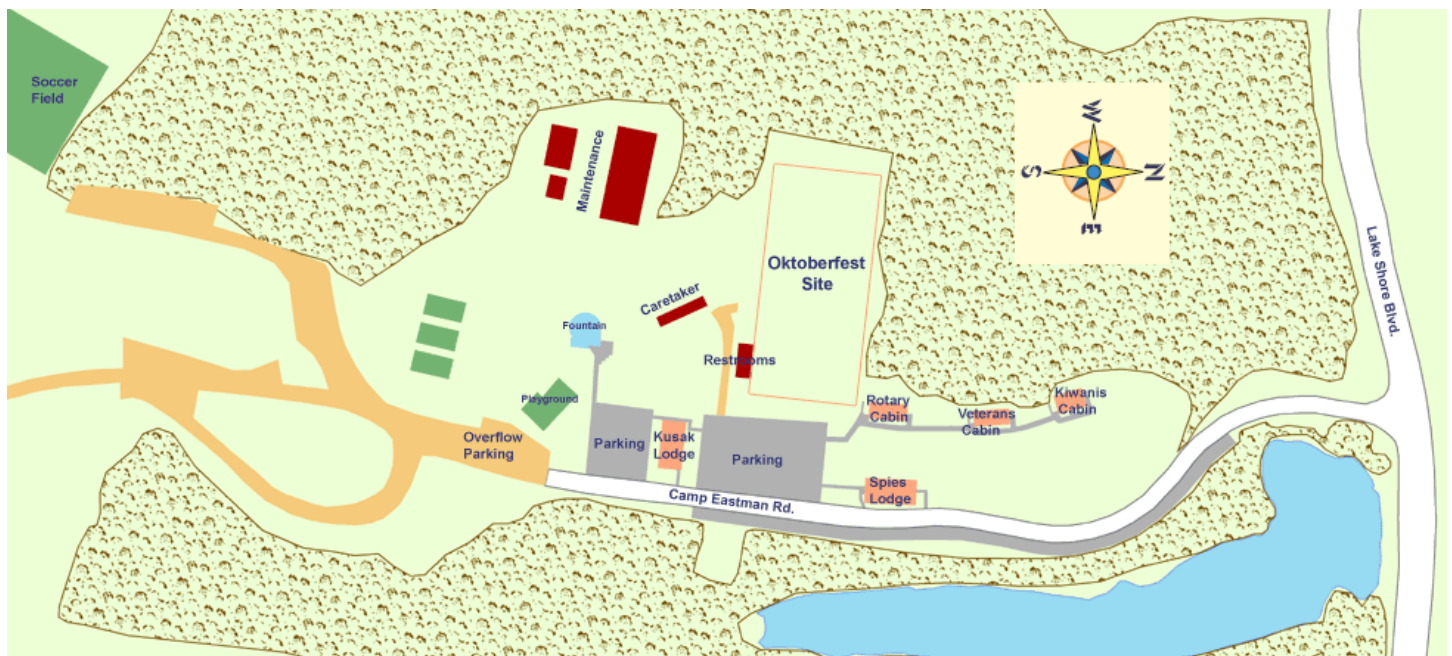

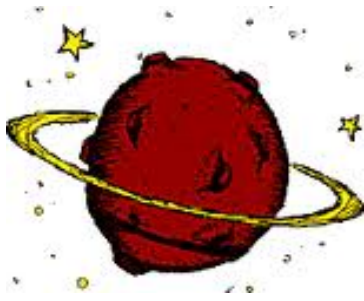


Camp Eastman is on the West edge of Durand-Eastman Park in Irondequoit

Outer Space Twilight Camp launches June 2011.



What is Twilight Camp? Twilight Camp is Seneca Waterway's premier 'Day Camp' for Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts. It is conducted by the council under certified leadership at an approved site. The camp is offered in the early evening hours and does not include any overnight activities. Scouts will attend on all 4 evenings accompanied by their parent or Cub Scout leader, but will return home to sleep. **It's a Cub Scout Camp in the Evening!**

Who: Any and all Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts or Webelos Scout and their parent or Cub Scout Leader. (**This is not a drop-off program**)

When: Monday, June 20th – Thurs, June 23rd, 5PM – 8:30PM

Where: Camp Eastman, Durand-Eastman Park, Irondequoit. Please see the **Map Page**.

Cost: \$40 per Scout (if registered by 5/23)– includes dinner all 4 nights, shirt, patch and four nights of fantastic camp program (3 events per night)! Parents/Leaders may purchase meals at \$2.50/night. You must be pre-registered/pre-paid.

Twilight Camp Do's and Don'ts

Wood Projects

Dress: Wear Action Uniform ('Class B') and Sneakers – Camp Shirt qualifies as an Action Uniform. Wednesday is Water Night, so bring a swim suit/towel. This is a high energy event – bring a water bottle!

Arts and Crafts

Supervision: Parents or Pack Representatives should plan on staying with their Scouts (1 adult per 5 Scouts). **This is NOT a drop off camp.**

Medical Issues: There will be medical staff on hand at the camp to handle emergencies. Parents or Pack Representatives are required to **have completed Medical Forms** (Parts A and C) for all participants (youth and adult) on hand.

Diet Issues: A standard, nutritious meal is provided on each night as part of the camp. If you have special dietary needs, you are urged to bring whatever food you may need. The camp has no way to provide or store special-needs meals.

Advancement

Family: Thursday is Family Night, and all are invited. You may purchase additional meals if need be. Due to space limitations and this being a highly popular event, only children in Cub Scouts may attend, except on Family Night.

Registration: Walk-Ins will NOT be accepted on the day of the event. You must be pre-registered and pre-paid. *All Scouts from the same pack should be registered on a single sheet to insure that they will be grouped together.* Adults wishing meal-service (\$2.50/night) also need to pre-register and pre-pay for the evenings they need.

Cutoffs: Registrations must be turned into the Council Service-center by Sat, June 11th, 2011, 5:00 PM. No late registrations will be accepted. We can accommodate no more than 150 Cub Scouts total and past Twilight Camps have always sold-out (with long waiting lists) – register early!

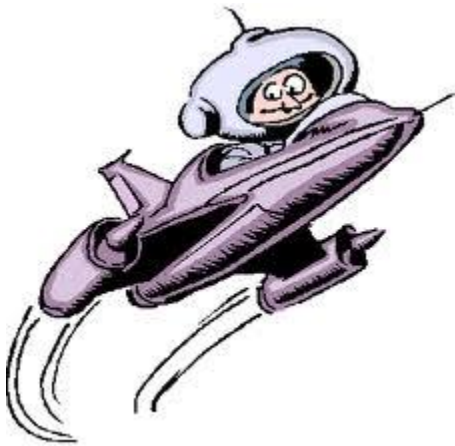
Twilight Camp FAQ

What is Twilight Camp? Twilight Camp is Seneca Waterway's premier 'Day Camp' for Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts. It is conducted by the council under certified leadership at an approved site. The camp is offered in the early evening hours and does not include any overnight activities. Scouts will attend on all 4 evenings accompanied by their parent or Cub Scout leader, but will return home to sleep. **It's a Cub Scout Camp in the Evening!**

When is Twilight Camp? Twilight Camp is Mon, June 20th through Thurs, June 23rd, 2011. It is conveniently located at Camp Eastman, Durand-Eastman Park in Irondequoit, NY. Activities start at 5PM and generally conclude by 8:30PM.

It starts at 5PM? The 5PM-6PM hour is used for packs to gather, for everyone to arrive and for everyone to eat. There is usually a 'gathering activity' to keep everyone entertained during this first hour, but the main camp activities commence around 6PM. Yes, we try to accommodate parent's work schedules.

I don't know how to get everyone there on time? Durand-Eastman is fairly easy to get to on Lake Shore Blvd from either Route 104 or I-590. Most Cub Scout Packs will coordinate/car-pool such that some parents will arrive straight from work, while others travel in from the suburbs with the kids. We also provide dinner in order to help simplify things. It generally works itself out.



How much is Twilight Camp? Twilight Camp is generally regarded as one of the best values in Cub Scouting. Attendees that register by 5/23 will pay as little as \$40 to attend Twilight Camp. This covers admission for activities all four evenings, dinner each night, plus the camp T-shirt AND activity patch.

What kind of activities does Twilight Camp offer? Twilight camp is organized around a theme – this year's theme is "Outer Space". Each night, there are 3 main activities (plus assorted side activities). Activities may include things like wood craft, science, construction projects, Scout skills and lore, and of course games. Popular events from past years have included things like the monkey-bridge obstacle course, water-bottle rockets and catapult construction.

How do I sign up for Twilight Camp? We encourage packs to register as a group (so we can keep everyone together). One person (typically a leader) from your pack should be appointed the "coordinator" and you'll let them know you are interested – they will register everyone at once. The coordinator will get all the official information, and is in charge of letting you know everything about camp.

Dear Cub Scout Leader:

Cub Scouts have always participated in Day Camps. The only problem with this is that Day Camps usually are run between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. – right in the middle of our workdays! This forces us to do one or more of the following: go to work late, leave work early, skip work, take vacation days, or not send our sons to camp at all. We have always considered the Cub Scout Program to be a family centered program, and have worked to make it easier for everyone.

Twilight Camp began in 2005 as a response to this problem and has been hugely successful. The camp is similar to a traditional day camp, but run in the evening hours. The Cub Scout Twilight Camp is again going to be held at Camp Eastman in Irondequoit, and this year will be based on an Outer Space theme. It is scheduled to run from June 20th through the 23rd between the hours of 5:00 PM. and 8:30 PM. We will be providing the Scouts a meal each evening. Parents are welcome to eat with the Scouts for a moderate (\$2.50) cost per meal, which must be pre-ordered and pre-paid. Scouts will participate in three activities each evening, and may consist of items such as songs, wood projects, nature, water-park activities and much more. Each Scout will also receive a t-shirt and patch for attending the camp.

I have enclosed a copy of the information and registration sheet. Please share this information with the other families in your den and/or Pack. We are encouraging you to **register by Packs or Dens**, but individual families may also sign-up if no one else from your Pack is coming. **THIS IS NOT A DROP OFF CAMP.** Parents are required to stay at the camp with their son. It is the only way we can keep the cost of camp so low. Registrations are due by 5:00 PM, June 11th, 2011. **NO LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AND NO WALK-IN REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED THE DAY OF THE EVENT.** If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact either of us. Our contact information is listed below. We look forward to seeing you at the 2011 Cub Scout Twilight Camp, Outer Space. Attendance is limited to the first 150 Cub Scouts that sign up. Medical Forms need to be completed and kept with the Pack Representative at the event.
